Complies with carpet manufacturer's guidelines for "Wet Side" cleaning.

DIRECTIONS:

DRY FOAM OR MIST CLEANING:

- 1) Place "WET FLOOR" signs around the area to be cleaned. Vacuum carpet thoroughly.
- 2) Dilute at 4 ounces of water (1:32).
- 3) Follow normal mist or dry foam shampoo procedures.

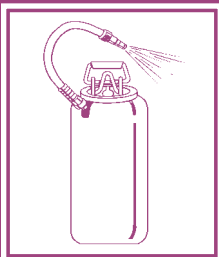
BONNET CLEANING:

- 1) Place "WET FLOOR" signs around the area to be cleaned. Vacuum carpet thoroughly to remove as much soil as possible.
- 2) Dilute this product at 4 ounces per gallon of water (1:32).
- 3) Use as follows:
 - a) Immerse carpet bonnet in a bucket containing this product. Remove from solution and wring dry.
- OR
- b) Place bonnet on the bottom of the floor machine. Spray bonnet with this product properly diluted using a pump sprayer. Lightly mist carpet area to be cleaned with this product also.
- 4) Bonnet clean a 100 to 150 square foot area and repeat steps 3A or 3B.
- 5) Turn or replace bonnet pad when it becomes exceptionally soiled.
- 6) Allow carpet to dry. Vacuum thoroughly.

**As with all cleaning products, always check for colorfastness on carpeting and upholstery in an inconspicuous area before using these products.*

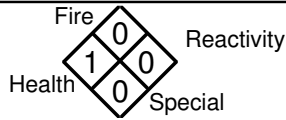
